Dear Parents,

Reading

We are doing Reading Street Unit 1 Week 1 this week. Our spelling and reading tests will be Thursday. The Unit 1 focus is How are people and animals important to one another. The question of the week is what do pets need. Our story this week is "Sam, Come Back." We will learn to read segment and blend words with short a and final ck; (at, am, plan, back, Nick, lock). We will learn to identify character and setting, and monitor our reading to clarify understanding. We will work on reading accurately.

Math

We will continue Chapter 2: Subtraction Concepts. We will subtract numbers from 10 or less. We will show taking from a number with pictures. We will model taking from a group. We will model taking apart. We will solve subtraction problems by making a model. We will use pictures to compare and subtract. We will use models to compare and subtract. We will tell what happens when we subtract 0 from a number. We will show all the ways to take apart a number. We will tell why some subtraction facts are easy to subtract. The Chapter 2 test should be Tuesday October 11th.

Spelling

We took our first spelling pretest last Friday. We begin each new week of Reading Street with a spelling pretest. This is used as a gauge for growth and a check for current understanding of coming phonics skill. It is a true pretest and the students are not given the words ahead of time. On the back of all spelling tests we also do a dictation test. I tell them a sentence to write down. They are expected to write it as correctly as they can. The words past spelling or high frequency words, or words that fit the past spelling patterns. Dictation is scored out of 7 points. One point each for correct category; capitalization, lowercase, spelling, punctuation, sentence completeness, handwriting, and word spacing. I use this to check for correct writing mechanics without the students having to also decide what to write.



Here are ways to help your child practice skills while having fun!

Day 1

Write these words on a sheet of paper: *man*, *men*, *can*, *had*, *lad*, *run*, *ran*, *cat*, *cot*, *bat*. Read each word aloud. Have your child tell you if the word has the short *a* sound. If it does, have your child write it and read it aloud.

Day 2

Write these words on a sheet of paper: back, sack, pack, rack, tack. Have your child read the words. Then have him or her act out the word as you guess it.

Day 3

Copy these words onto cards: *my, way, come, on, in*. Tell your child these are "Boing" words. Read a story together. If a "Boing" word is read, your child should jump up and yell, "Boing!"

Day 4

Write each spelling word on a card: *at, can, cat, back, dad, am, bat, mad, ran, sack*. Have your child sort the words according to his or her own rules. Then have him or her spell each word.

Day 5

This week your child is learning about the characters and setting in a story. Read a story and ask your child to tell you who it is about and where it takes place.
