# Dear Parents,

## Reading

We are doing Reading Street Unit 1 Week 3 this week. Our spelling and reading tests will be Thursday. The Unit 1 focus is how people and animals are important to one another. The question of the week is how do animals help people? Our story this week is "The Big Blue Ox." We will learn to read, segment and blend words with short o and plural –s, and consonant s /z/; (bob, box, bats, bins, jobs, kids). We will review character and setting in stories. We will work on reading accurately. We will learn to identify and write predicates of sentences.

### Math

We will continue Chapter 3: Addition Strategies. We will solve addition problems. We will tell what happens if we change the order of the addends when we add. We will count on 1, 2, or 3. We will tell what doubles facts are. We will use doubles to help add. We will use what we know about doubles to find other sums. We will use strategies to solve addition fact problems. We will use a ten frame to add 10 and some more. We will use the make a ten strategy to add. We will make a ten to help add. We will add three addends. We will group numbers to add three addends. We will solve addition word problems by drawing a picture. The Chapter 3 test should be Friday, November 4<sup>th</sup>.

# Here are ways to help your child practice skills while having fun!

Day 1

Write these words on paper: rock, lock, hop, mop, top, got, hot, pot. Then using crayons, write the first letter of each word in one color and have your child finish writing the word in another color and read the words.

Day 2

Together, write silly rhymes using the plural forms of the words in this list: cat, rat, pig, wig, sack, tack, mop, top, rock, sock.

Day 3

Write each of these words on two index cards: *blue, from, help, little, use, get*. Read the words with your child. Mix up the cards and place them faceup on a table. Choose one card and have your child find the matching card.

Day 4

Read each spelling word aloud: *mom*, *hot*, *hop*, *pot*, *pop*, *ox*, *lock*, *mop*, *got*, *rock*. Have your child write the words as you read them and then write the plural forms of *pot*, *lock*, and *rock*.

Day 5

This week your child is learning about the characters and setting in a story. Read a story to your child. Have your child tell you who the story is about and name any other people or animals in the story. Ask your child to tell you where the story takes place.

# Hop, Hop Frog

**Materials** index cards, marker, paper, pencil, 1 coin per player

### **Game Directions**

- 1. Copy the words below on index cards and place the cards facedown on the table.
- 2. Each player puts a coin on **Start**. The first player picks a word card and reads it aloud. Then he or she writes the plural form of the word on paper.
- 3. Each time a player writes the plural form of the word correctly, he or she can "hop" his or her coin to the next lily pad. Play then continues to the next player.
