## Day 4

Write the spelling words in a list: unhappy, refill, untie, undo, repay, unkind, undress, retell, reopen, rewind. Have students copy each word on a card or small piece of paper and sort the words according to prefixes.

Day 5
This week your child is learning about theme. Recall the story you made up about a bad day. Retell the story as a good day by changing the outcome of the events. Ask you child to rename the story and draw a new picture.

## Spin and Spell
